Congratulations on your acceptance to the Marist Freshman Florence Experience (FFE). To confirm your participation in the FFE Program, you must return this enrollment form. Please note that enrollment can only be guaranteed once your official deposit of \$500 has been received by the Office of Undergraduate Admission. If you have not already done so, please follow the deposit instructions included in your acceptance packet. Students who live outside of the United States are encouraged to fax/e-mail a copy of this enrollment form prior to mailing in order to expedite processing.

Participation in the FFE requires that students enroll as full-time, degree-seeking freshmen at Marist College as outlined in the acceptance packet sent by the Office of Undergraduate Admission. Students participating in programs such as the Arthur O. Eve Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP), the Learning Disabilities Program, or NCAA Division I Athletes are not eligible to participate in the FFE. Please note the terms and conditions of the FFE program below.

Terms and Conditions

I, the undersigned, understand that the Freshman Florence Experience (FFE) is a one-year program that requires two semesters of full-time study at the Marist College campus in Florence, Italy. Mid-semester transfers between campuses are not permitted. I am aware that housing in Florence will be in a freshman residence and is mandatory for all FFE participants for the entire academic year.

I understand that by signing this form and enrolling in the FFE program, I am forfeiting my placement in the Marist College Poughkeepsie campus for the academic year 2019-2020, and that I must complete the FFE program to qualify for housing on the Poughkeepsie campus in subsequent years.

I understand that a change of status or location at any point in the year may involve financial penalties, including housing charges for foreign accommodations.

I recognize that it is my responsibility to read and understand the policies of Marist College and the Marist-LdM Program in Florence, Italy. These policies include, but are not limited to, financial services policies, the undergraduate academic catalog, the student code of conduct, and the resident life handbook.

Participation in this study abroad program will also require valid immigration documents, including a current passport and student visa.
